❖ *Mission and philosophy*

It is the duty of the board to ascertain that only qualified individuals are licensed to practice and that all sanitary and shop licensing rules set for by statute are adhered to, thereby insuring public health and well-being.

❖ *Results of outcomes*

The Board of Barber Examiners administered two board examinations, inspected 103 shops and licensed 176 barbers.

Numbers are diminishing in the barber profession. Wyoming has lost 56 barbers since 1996, and the number of shops has also decreased. The board has problems with timely renewals and is working to make that system more efficient.

❖ *Strategic plan changes*

The board will continue to upgrade record keeping and the licensure process. The board will continue to encourage license holders to become more familiar with state statutes, sanitary rules and regulations and the license fee structure along with due date.
